### **1.- Target participants**

This Call for evidence (CfE) is addressed to EU benchmark administrators, Non-EU benchmark administrators currently active on the EU market under the BMR's transitional provisions, EU benchmark users (banks, investment funds, asset managers), EU benchmark end-users (investors, businesses), and Public authorities.

### **2.- Information Note**

This CfE has aims to tackle the following problems:

- 1) Ensuring continued access to benchmarks worldwide for EU businesses and investors. The initiative aims to ensure that EU businesses and investors have access to a more diverse, more innovative and more advantageous set of benchmarks to use for hedging, investment, etc.
- 2) Promoting EU benchmark labels (EU CTBs and EU PABs) as an open standard under EU supervision. The initiative seeks to ensure that non-EU administrators offering EU climate transition benchmarks and EU Paris-aligned benchmarks are subject to EU supervision of all label-related BMR provisions.
