<u>Public consultation on the review of the European long-term investment</u> funds (ELTIF) regulatory framework

1.- Target audience

This consultation is addressed to all stakeholders. Responses are expected from persons and entities representing Member States, national competent authorities and/or ESMA, market participants such as asset managers, investment firms, credit institutions, financial intermediaries, stock exchanges, retail and institutional investors, consumer and investor organisations, manufacturers and distributors of financial products and services as well as academics and policy think-tanks.

2. - Information Note

Several years after the adoption of the legal regime of the ELTIF, only about 28 ELTIFs have been registered, with a very low asset base (below 2 billion euros). The relatively low uptake of these products, together with the recommendations of the High-Level Forum on the Capital Markets Union concerning the targeted revision of the ELTIF Regulation, support the need of a public consultation on the functioning of the regime. The responses to this consultation are essential for a proper performance evaluation. The consultation consists of 42 questions covering different areas of the regulatory framework and functioning of the ELTIF.

3.- Submission of comments

The deadline for submitting comments is **19 January 2021.**

Stakeholders should send their contributions through an online questionnaire available on the <u>Furopean Commission</u> website (place the cursor over the word to obtain the link) where the document to be consulted can also be found.
